In most instances, these items are produced in injection blow moulding machines, which require considerable investment in equipment and accessories. Wei Li says that its WL-APog can be viewed as a cost-effective and energy-efficient option for processors. Processors can even make use of their existing injection machines in their factory to produce the required PMMA or PC preforms.

This machine can blow PET bottles and jars up to a volume 16 litres and neck diameter up to 200 mm.

Hong Kong-based Wei Li says that it has exported its range of stretch blow moulders to more than 22 countries in Asia Africa Europe, North America and South America. The company also provides advise on preform and bottle design as well as technical support. (222)
